XA22 Stag handle corkscrew with Ram's head. Back silver mount has initial M with years 1879-1904 (25th Birthday? – nice gift!). Marked STERLING. The inner sleeve has slipped down so there is play in the bell. The bell cap is Edwin Walker's April 17, 1900 U. S. Patent number 647,775. 7.5" x 6.25". A very impressive corkscrew! \$1675





XA24 Large stag handle with boar's head carving. Center wrap is marked STERLING with monogram and date March 10, 1902. From nose to tail in a direct line it is 10". \$1450



XA28 Stag handle with Bison head mount marked STERLING. The bell cap is Edwin Walker's April 17, 1900 U. S. Patent number 647,775. 7.75" x 6". \$1675



XA31 Boar's tusk with silver three horse head design applied. The larger silver mount is marked STERLING. The bell cap is Edwin Walker's April 17, 1900 U. S. Patent number 647,775. The smaller mount is a nice design but a piece is broken off. 6" x 6.25". \$695



XA32 Boar's tusk corkscrew with carving of a two faces – happy and sad. Silver mount marked STERLING. The bell cap is Edwin Walker's April 17, 1900 U. S. Patent number 647,775. 6.5" x 6.25". \$1475





XA33 Carved tusk handle with swirl design. Silver bands and end caps – all four are marked STERLING. 5" x 6". 100 times better in person than in photos. \$795



XA34 Tusk handle corkscrew with silver torch bearing lady applied. The small silver cap is marked 925. 5" x 6.25". The large end is nice and flat – perfect for engraving to give to a friend. 1897 Williamson patent corkscrew with wire cutter and cap lifter. \$850





XA43 Antler handle corkscrew with a deer head carved at the end and a dog underneath. The bell cap is Edwin Walker's April 17, 1900 U. S. Patent number 647,775. 9.5" x 6.5". \$775





XA54 Henshall button type corkscrew with boar's tusk handle. Silver mount not marked. Fluted helix. 6" x 6.5". \$275



XA100 Corkscrew with medallion attached "Royal National Parks of Kenya". Rhinoceros on medallion. 3" x 4".




XA102 Bone handle Henshall type corkscrew. Excellent with a couple of hairline age cracks – see back of center photo. 4.75" x 6". \$125



XA115 Stag handle corkscrew with ball ends. The bell cap is Edwin Walker's April 17, 1900 U. S. Patent number 647,775. 6.75" x 6.5". \$125





XA116 Stag handle corkscrew with silver mounts. The back mount has the Gorham mark and STERLING B2313. The front mount has some fancy silver work. There is a minor ding on the face. Ideal for monogram. 7" x 6". \$275



XA117 Stag handle corkscrew with silver mounts. Top of frame is marked GERMANY. Marked STERLING 69 with the maker's mark of Wilcox & Waggoner, New York. 9" x 7". \$275




XA123 1886 Edward Thiéry and Charles Croselmire

XA125 Large stag handle corkscrew with silver mount marked STERLING 132 and maker's mark. The cap is nice and flat – perfect for an engraving to a friend (black in photo is a reflection). 9" x 7". \$275

XA134 Wonderfully carved tusk showing a gnome or child in stocking hat amongst grapes, leaves and vine. Silver mounts – nicely decorated large one marked STERLING. The self-pulling bell is Edwin Walker's U. S. Patent 501,975, July 25, 1893. 8" x 5.75". Super fine corkscrew. \$1875



Designs were cut into the silver after it was electroplated to an object as on this corkscrew. Interestingly the handle is hollow! 3.5" x 5.25". \$576
