FF110 Bather, 6.75"h., three flower holes, parasol shown is not original parasol, bottom solid, orange ink stamp "MADE IN JAPAN." Exc. Cond. \$45.





FF087 Maiden Posed in Lotus, painted accents, 8.5"h., eight flower holes, large hole in center of base, stamped in gold "Germany." There is one black dot in her hair and one on her right leg. Her chin and nose are fine, no damage. The other dots in the photograph just aren't there. Exc. Cond. \$70





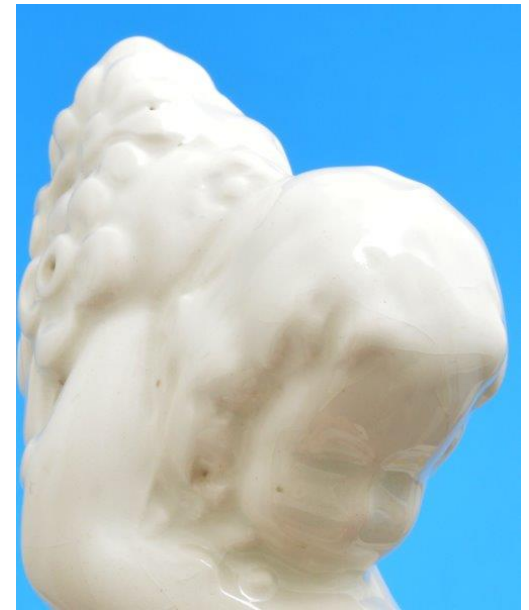
FF088 This was given to me by a friend as a flower holder. It could be a cigarette holder. It has a bisque base with a single hole. The water does not flow from the legs out the bottom hole. 3 ¼”h. x 3 1/8”w. x 1 ½” deep. Marked “Germany Dep. 16831.” Very Good Cond. \$45





FF089 Scarf Dancer, 8.25"h., bloom on front and back of base, bisque bottom with two holes in a center oval indent, impressed "4592 Germany." Slight chip on front flower hole left of center, brown spots at center back around flower hole. \$60





FF090 Maiden with Flower Garland. 8 ½”h. Light overall crazing, otherwise fine. No chips or cracks. Impressed “9069.”

FF091 Scarf Dancer with Leg Back. 7"h., stamped "Germany."  
Lighter weight, better quality pottery than 094. Light crazing  
overall, hairline crack at base bottom edge left of center that  
can't be seen in enlarged photo. \$25





FF092 Cornucopia Dancer, bisque bottom with two holes in a center oval indent, impressed "7599 Germany." White marks at center base are lack of green paint, not damaged. Exc. Cond. \$85



FF093 Lady Bather with shell and coral motif on base, 7.5"h., base bottom is stamped "Germany" in blue and impressed "5621" on back of base. Her eyes have tiny orange dots in the center. Water staining on base bottom and around the inside of some holes. She has a molding squiggle and crack on base top and slight molding crack on base bottom. No other chips or cracks. \$38



FF094 Scarf Dancer with Leg Back. 6.25"h., not marked, no chips or cracks. Features are fuzzy. Dip in bottom center hole is a molding defect. \$20



FF095 Seated Nude with Double Candleholder, 7.25"h. x 7"w. candleholder to candleholder, bottom impressed "8776." Tiny brown speckles on back two holes left side. No chips or cracks. \$75



FF096 Scarf Dancer with Leg up, 6.25"h., not marked. Others have been seen marked "Germany." Light crazing overall, no chips or cracks. \$23



FF097 Sonja Henie. 6.5" h., base is 4" l. x 2" w. She is impressed with the Goebel mark that dates from 1935-1949. Sonja Henie was a Norwegian figure skater who won three Olympic gold medals. After retiring from competitive skating, she acted in several Hollywood films. She was born in 1912 and died in 1969. Exc. Cond. \$125





FF098 Double Dancers Insert with Flower Holder Bowl, 8.25"h. Bowl is 8"w. and marked "8684/H." Brown spot on hair of one, two chips on top rim of bowl, not visible with insert in place. 1" hairline crack from inner rim of bowl to next rim edge. The ladies are in very good condition. \$65

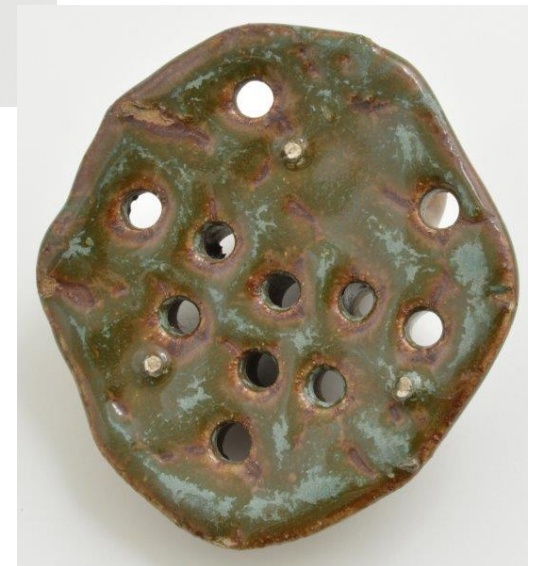




FF099 Peters and Reed. Landsun Disk, 3.5"d. x 1.25"h., nineteen flower holes, four indents for water flow, not marked. Exc. Cond. \$23



FF100 Peters and Reed. Lily Leaf in green matte glaze over red clay with glazed bottom, 4"w. x 1.75"h., not marked. Discoloration or wear around one flower hole at leaf split, otherwise exc. \$38



FF101 Peters and Reed. Frog in high gloss mottled glaze, red clay body, 4"w., bottom is glazed, not marked. Light chip/dot at base rim below frog face, also at rim on frog's right side. \$40 **SOLD**



FF102 Brush McCoy. Frog, shape #03V, 4.5"l. x 4"w. x 2.5"h., eight flower holes in his back, not marked. Art Vellum Line, c.1923. Exc. Cond. \$65 **SOLD**



FF103 Brush McCoy Lily Pad with Turtle, shape #04V, 2"h. x 4"w., seven flower holes, not marked. Art Vellum Line, c.1923. Slight chip on underside of base. Light crazing, when magnified, but not visible to the naked eye. Lighter mark on edge of leaf is part of original firing. \$65 **SOLD**

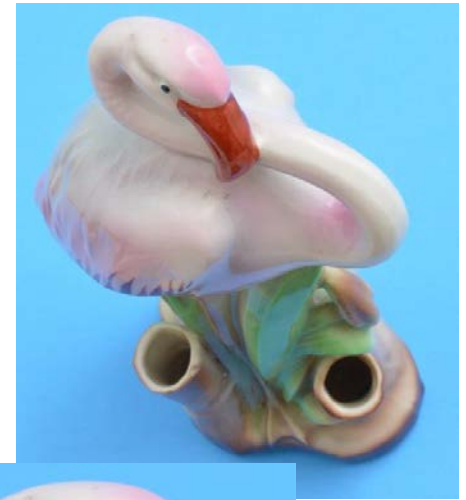


FF104 Blue Bird. 3.25"h. with a 2.5" diameter base. Slight molding drip/discoloration on bottom base rim-- not a chip. Exc. Cond.

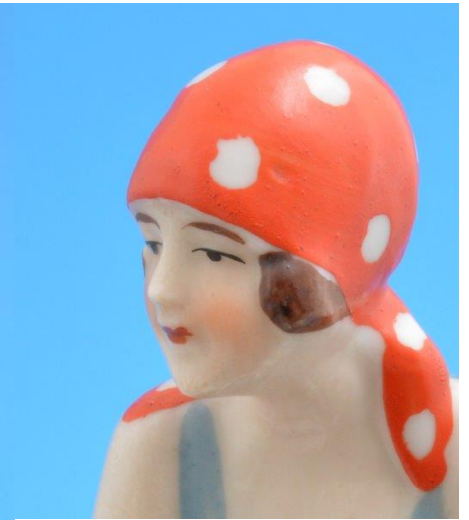
FF105 Green Bird. 3.25"h. with a 2.5" diameter base. Exc. Cond.

FF106 Flamingo. 6 ½ "h. x 4" w. tail to neck, base 3" w. x 2 ½" deep.  
Not marked, exc. cond. \$75



FF107 Presumed German. Girl with rose motif dress, bobbed hair, 6.5"h., not marked. Some white spots on lower base, otherwise, exc. cond. \$95



FF108 Bather in Blue, hole in right hand for parasol, 6.75"h., self-contained, four flower holes on either side of legs with 1/2" hole in back, impressed "8521" on bottom. A few white spots on lower base, otherwise exc. \$85.



FF109 Bather in Green and Black, hole in right hand to hold parasol (parasol shown is not the original), 5"h., self-contained, six flower holes in front, impressed on back at bottom "10513." Exc. Cond. \$85
